1. APPLICATION FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAM

The enrollment procedure for the Beginner Chinese Language Course at Confucius Institute at the

University of the Zagreb, in the summer semester of 2023/2024, starts with the application to an

entrance exam.

Applications for the entrance exam are made <u>through the online form</u> (\leftarrow <u>click on the link!</u>)

Applications are accepted from Friday, January 26, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. to Friday, February 9,

2024, at 2:00 p.m.

Please enter the required information correctly as it will be used throughout the entire process of your

entrance exam, enrollment, and in later stages, your course attendance and issuance of a course

completion certificate.

Please note that applications are received ONLY through the online form and ONLY at the specified

time (starting on Friday, January 26, 2024, at 10:00, a.m., ending on Friday, February 9, 2024, at 2:00

p.m.). Applications out of the specified time will not be taken into account in any case, as well as

phone applications or applications sent by e-mail.

2. MATERIALS FOR THE ENTRANCE EXAM

All registered candidates will receive a confirmation email with the password for self-enrolment to the

online course Entrance Exam 02-2024 on the website https://usavrsavanje.loomen.carnet.hr/

The materials required for the preparation and successful passing of the entrance exam will be

available to all registered candidates within the system from the moment they enrol for the

course Entrance Exam 02-2024.

The preparation materials are in English.

3. ENTRANCE EXAM

The entrance exam will be available at https://usavrsavanje.loomen.carnet.hr/ from Friday,

January 26, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. to Sunday, February 11, 2024, at 13:00 p.m.

The exam will contain 25 questions from the language and cultural part, and writing a short

motivational text. The maximum number of points that can be obtained on the exam is 100. Exam

questions are in English. The exam is conducted through an online system at

https://usavrsavanje.loomen.carnet.hr/

To take the exam, we recommend using a computer or a laptop to avoid technical difficulties.

Candidates will be ranked according to the number of points achieved in the language and cultural part

of the exam, while the motivational text will be taken into consideration in case several candidates

have the same number of points.

The entrance exam results of the candidates who didn't fill in the application form will not be

taken into consideration.

4. RESULTS OF THE ENTRANCE EXAM AND ENROLLMENT

The first, unofficial results of the entrance exam will be sent to all candidates by e-mail on Tuesday,

February 13, 2024, by 1:00 p.m.

Appeals and objections to the results of the entrance exam can be submitted to the three-

member appealing committee of Confucius Institute at the University of Zagreb, from Tuesday,

February 13, 2024, from 1:00 p.m. to Wednesday, February 14, 2024, until 1:00 p.m. The

appealing committee will decide on timely submitted appeals and objections on Thursday, January 15,

2024.

Final and official results will be sent to all candidates by e-mail on Thursday, January 15, 2024,

by 1:00 p.m.

Enrollment of the accepted candidates will be conducted from Thursday, January 15, 2024, at

1:00 p.m., by the results of the entrance exam.





The classification of candidates into groups during enrollment will be done automatically by the Confucius Institute at the University of Zagreb, following the selection of the group that candidates marked. The timetable will be sent to all candidates by email. Candidates can choose preferred groups from Monday, February 5, 2024, to Friday, February 9, 2024. Candidates who fail to select a group within the given deadline will be assigned to the groups where there are still vacancies.

5. ABOUT THE BEGINNER CHINESE LANGUAGE COURSE

Starting date: February 11, 2024

Ending date: June 21, 2024

Duration: 70 teaching hours (2x90 minutes per week)

Teachers: Native Chinese speakers

Type of classes: Online and live at CI Zagreb classrooms

Equipment (for online): Headphones with a microphone, camera, computer or a laptop

Please note that, in accordance with the teaching rules of the Confucius Institute at the University of Zagreb, it is required to attend at least 70% of the class, to be able to take the final exam. In addition to the final exam, participants will also have one midterm exam during the semester. The overall, final grade of each participant in the course consists of several elements (teaching assignments during the semester 40% of the total grade, midterm exam 20% of the total grade, final exam 40% of the total grade, with the condition of achieving a score of 60% to pass the final exam). At least 60% of all elements must be achieved for the successful completion of the semester. Classes are held in English and Chinese. Confucius Institute of the University of Zagreb will provide all the materials necessary for teaching. The course is free of charge.
